Middle School Supply List

5th grade: black or blue ink pens (no gel pens), 12 #2 pencils with erasers, 2 dry erase markers, crayons, scissors, 4 pocket folders, 4 wide ruled notebook paper, hi-liter, glue, ruler, protractor, backpack, composition book.

Honors Reading/Language Arts: one 3 ring binder (1 1/2 inch), three 2 pocket folders (plastic) with holes to put in binder, 1 composition notebook, packages of loose leaf paper for binder, flash drive, 100 lined index cards, clipboard labeled with name.

Honors Math: lined paper, ruler, calculator, plastic folder with pocket and clips, graph paper, 1 spiral notebook, 1 box of crayons or colored pencils, 1 large bottle of Elmer's brand glue, scissors, one - 1 gallon Ziplock bag with student's name on it.

6th grade: one 2 pocket folder with prongs for each class, binder with loose leaf paper, multiple boxes of #2 pencils, 3 whole pencil pouch, colored pencils, pens, hi-lighters, Expo markers, 2 composition notebooks.

Spanish Rotation: 1-inch 3 ring binder w/ pocket, 100 lined index cards

Honors Reading/Language Arts: one 3 ring binder (1 1/2 inch), three 2 pocket folders (plastic) with holes to put in binder, 1 composition notebook, packages of loose leaf paper for binder, flash drive, 100 lined index cards, clipboard labeled with name, 2 spiral notebooks, colored ink pens.

Honors Math: lined paper, ruler, calculator, plastic folder with pocket and clips, graph paper, 1 spiral notebook, 1 box of crayons or colored pencils, 1 large bottle of Elmer's brand glue, scissors, dry erase markers, 1 pkg of 3x3 post-it notes, one - 1 gallon Ziplock bag with student's name on it.

7th grade P.E.- 1-2 pocket folder, PE uniform purchased in the classroom, tennis shoes suitable for running, black/blue pen, and/or pencil.

Elementary School Supply List

Requirement: Tennis shoes for physical education class.

Additional supplies may be requested by the individual classroom teacher.

Due to limited space, please do not bring trapper keepers and backpacks should not have wheels.

Kindergarten – A backpack and \$6.50 fee for Weekly Reader. Your child’s teacher will have a supply list specific to their classroom.

First Grade – A backpack, 1 box of #2 yellow pencils with erasers, box of 24 Crayola crayons, thin washable markers, 1 pkg. of Expo dry-erase markers, 1 box of Kleenex, scissors (prefer Fiskar blunt tip), 6 glue sticks, 1 bottle of liquid glue, 1 pocket folder, 1 large eraser, 1 bottle of pump hand sanitizer, 1 package of Lysol wipes, 1 box gallon size baggies (prefer Ziploc), small plastic school supply box **for Mrs. Mishler, Mrs. Lasley ONLY.**

Second Grade – A backpack, 2 boxes of #2 pencils with erasers, a large eraser, a 12oz. bottle of hand sanitizer, 24 pack of crayons, 1 set of colored pencils, 2 boxes of Kleenex, scissors, large bottle of glue, 4 glue sticks, 4 pocket folders, a ruler w/inches and centimeters, small school box or pouch, 3 spiral-bound notebooks (70 pages each), one 4-pack low odor dry erase markers, \$6.00 fee for Weekly Reader..

Third Grade – A backpack, 24 sharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical), large pink eraser, 2 boxes of Kleenex, scissors (not rounded, but not adult size), 4 glue sticks, 5 pocket folders with prongs, a ruler with inches and centimeters, box of 24 crayons, zip-up pencil pouch, 1 box of dry erase markers black only, fine tip, washable markers, 1 package colored pencils, 2 highlighters, 1-pkg of Post-it-notes, 2 composition books (not spiral), 1 small pencil sharpener, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer with pump.

Fourth Grade – A backpack, 1 ink pen (black or blue), 2 boxes of #2 pencils with erasers, pencil sharpener, box of 24 crayons, box of markers, 1 box of Kleenex, scissors, 4 glue sticks, 6 plain pocket folders (one that is yellow and one that is purple), pencil pouch (no boxes please), 4 composition books, highlighters, 1 pack of loose leaf wide ruled notebook paper, post-it notes, 1 package of wide-tip dry erase markers, colored, pencils, protractor, ruler with inches and centimeters, 1 box each: gallon and quart Ziploc baggies.
